TICKETING TERMS & CONDITIONS (all prices in AUD)

- Tickets are open to the entire HR & Talent Community.
- Workshop access links and joining instructions will be provided to registered participants prior to the workshop commencement date.
- Each registration provides access for one individual participant only. Workshop access links must not be shared, distributed, or used by multiple attendees unless explicitly authorised by ATC in writing.
- ATC reserves the right to remove or deny access to any participant found sharing access links or breaching workshop participation terms.

ONLINE REGISTRATION AND BINDING AGREEMENT

By submitting a registration, including through ATC's online registration system, and accepting these Terms and Conditions, the registering person confirms that they are authorised to make the booking on behalf of the organisation identified in the registration. The submission of the registration constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions and creates a binding agreement between ATC and the organisation on whose behalf the registration is made. Electronic acceptance, including ticking an acceptance box and submitting an online registration, constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions and has the same effect as a signed agreement.

PAID AND DISCOUNTED TICKETS

Once a registration has been submitted, the organisation is liable for the applicable registration fee regardless of whether the registration fee has been paid, an invoice has been issued, or the organisation subsequently elects not to have the nominated Ticket Holder attend. Cancellation is subject to the Cancellation Policy set out in these Terms and Conditions.

The fee payable by the Ticket Holder under this Agreement is the amount stipulated on the registration form and is due and payable on the date of submission of such registration form with ATC.

If a tax invoice is requested, payment terms and conditions are stipulated on the tax invoice.

If a Ticket Holder has not paid prior to the workshop, the Ticket Holder agrees to pay via Credit Card before being admitted to the workshop. If a Ticket Holder has registered to attend and is absent, they are still liable for all ticket fees.

Registrations made within 7 days of the workshop must be paid via credit card unless prior arrangements have been made directly with ATC.

Promotional discounts, if applicable, can only be applied at the time of registration. Only 1 discount code can be applied per registration.

PAID REGISTRATION CANCELLATION POLICY

If the Ticket Holder notifies ATC that they can no longer attend the Workshop, the Ticket Holder is able to:-

(A) Name transfer: substitute the Ticket Holder's registration with another team member or colleague; or

(B) Workshop/event transfer: have the registration funds already paid, less an AU\$100 administration fee, credited towards a future ATC event scheduled within 12 months of the existing workshop. This applies to both pre-paid registrations as well as invoiced registrations that are not yet paid in full.

ATC must be advised of any name change or event transfer by Friday, 9th October 2026.

If the Ticket Holder fails to provide notice of name or workshop transfer to ATC by Friday, 9th October 2026 or who does not attend the workshop forfeits all fees paid to ATC and shall remain liable for any unpaid registration fees.

All name and workshop transfer requests must be submitted in writing to registrations@atcevents.com.au by the above-mentioned deadline.

All Cancellation Policy conditions apply regardless of when a Ticket Holder's ticket was purchased.

All workshop tickets purchased are non-refundable.

ATC has the right to cancel a Ticket Holder's registration if the Ticket Holder is not a member of the HR or Talent Professional Community or related roles and professions that have explicit permission to attend.

COMPLIMENTARY AND GIVEAWAY TICKETS

1. AGREEMENT TO TERMS, CONDITIONS AND RULES

The Ticket Holder, in submitting a registration form to Australasian Talent Conference Pty Ltd ("ATC") also known as ATC Events & Media ("ATC Events & Media") for attendance at the conference, agrees to observe and abide by the Terms and Conditions set forth below and by such additional Terms, Conditions and Rules made by Australasian Talent Conference Pty Ltd ("ATC") on notice to the Ticket Holder from time to time for the efficient or safe operation of the workshop.

2. ATTENDING THE ONLINE WORKSHOP

(A) Participants are responsible for ensuring they have adequate internet access and compatible technology to participate in the workshop.

(B) ATC is not responsible for participant connectivity issues, local technical failures, or restrictions caused by employer IT settings or firewalls.

(C) Recording, screen capturing, redistribution, reproduction, or commercial reuse of workshop content is strictly prohibited unless prior written permission has been granted by ATC.

(D) ATC reserves the right to remove participants from the workshop if behaviour is disruptive, inappropriate, abusive, or breaches these Terms and Conditions.

4. INABILITY TO HOLD AND CHANGES TO THE WORKSHOP

(A) If, due to technical failure, cyber incident, public emergency, trainer illness, force majeure event, or circumstances beyond ATC's reasonable control, the workshop or any part therefore cannot proceed as scheduled, ATC reserve the right to cancel the workshop and offer a credit transfer to the next workshop/event within 12 months for paid tickets.

(B) If ATC fails to run a workshop/event within the next 12 months from the date of the cancelled workshop, the Ticket Holder shall be entitled to a refund of the fee paid, less a proportionate deduction for any unrecoverable costs and expenses incurred by ATC.

(C) If the workshop is relocated or rescheduled to a date other than the advertised date, at which the Ticket Holder is unable to attend, the Ticket Holder shall be entitled to transfer their registration to an alternative delegate or shall receive a credit in the sum of the registration fee for use at any other ATC run workshop/event within 12 months from the date of the existing event.

(D) ATC aims to ensure all workshop details, agenda and speaker line-up are correct at the time of publishing and reserve the right to make changes to the workshop agenda without prior notice.

5. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY

(A) Neither ATC nor any of its officers, agents, employees, or other representatives shall be held liable for and are hereby released from, liability for any damage, loss, illness, harm or injury to the person or property of the Ticket Holder, resulting from any cause whatsoever.

(B) The Ticket Holder shall indemnify, defend, and protect ATC and hold and save ATC harmless from, any and all claims, demands, suits, liability, damages, loss, costs, attorney's fees and expenses of whatever kind or nature, which result from, arise out of or are connected with any acts, or omissions of the Ticket Holder.

(C) In no event shall ATC be liable for any consequential, indirect or special damages, whether foreseeable or unforeseeable, whether based upon lost goodwill, lost profits, or otherwise, and whether arising out of breach of any express or implied warranty, breach of contract, negligence, misrepresentation, strict liability in term, or otherwise, and whether based on this Agreement, any transaction performed or undertaken under or in connection with the Agreement, or otherwise. In any event, and in no way limiting the operation of this clause, the Ticket Holder agrees that the liability of ATC for damages, regardless of the form of action, shall be limited to the registration fee paid under by the Ticket Holder pursuant to this Agreement.

6. JURISDICTION

Each of ATC and the Ticket Holder hereby consents to the jurisdiction of Victoria having jurisdiction over this workshop for all purposes in connection with this Agreement and further consents that any process or notice of motion in connection therewith may be served by certified or registered mail or personal service, provided a reasonable time for appearance is allowed.

7. GOVERNING LAW; AMENDMENTS

This Agreement shall be governed by, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of Victoria. This Agreement may not be amended or modified except by a written communication by ATC.

8. SEVERABILITY; WAIVER

If any part of this Agreement is found invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain unaffected and enforceable. Any ATC decision, selection of any course of action, or exercise of any right or remedy is at its sole option and discretion and does not waive or prejudice ATC as to any other choice. ATC's failure at any time to require the Ticket Holder's strict compliance with an any part of this Agreement shall not thereafter waive or reduce ATC's right to require strict compliance with the same or any other provision of the Agreement.
